ORDINANCE 1983-01 AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE AND OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES IN THE TOWN OF RICHFORD, WAUSHARA COUNTY AMENDED

SECTION I – STATE SNOWMOBILE LAWS ADOPTED

State Snowmobile Laws are adopted except as otherwise specifically provided in this ordinance, the statutory provisions describing and defining regulations with respect to snowmobiles in the Wisconsin statutes are hereby adopted and made part of this ordinance. Acts required to be performed or prohibited by such statues are required or prohibited by this ordinance.

SECTION II – SNOWMOBILE ROUTES AND TRAILS DESIGNATED

Except as provided in <u>§350.02</u> and <u>350.045</u> of the Wisconsin Statutes, or for snowmobile events authorized in accordance with <u>§350.01</u> Wis. Stats., no person shall operate a snowmobile upon any public right-of-way, in any public part, or on any other public municipal property in the Town of Richford, except upon the following designated snowmobile routes and trails:

- 1. Marked trails in the town park in the SE ¼ of NW ¼ of Section 21 and at a speed not to exceed 5 m.p.h.
- 2. No person shall fail to obey any route or trail sign, marker or limit erected in accordance with this ordinance.

SECTION III – PENALTY

Wisconsin state snowmobile penalties as found in $\frac{350.11(1)(a)}{2}$ Wis Stats are adopted by reference.

SECTION IV – ENFORCEMENT

The uniform traffic citation promulgated under Wisconsin Statutes shall be used for violations for this ordinance relating to highway use and parking

SECTION V – SERVERABILITY

The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the town board would have passed the other provision, sections, subsections, paragraphs, clauses or phrases of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more of such parts may be declared invalid. If any provision or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION VI – EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting. The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under §60.80, Wis. stats. Adopted March 12, 2007.
